MEDICATION

Per NYS Education Law, students may receive medication at school *only* if it is medically necessary and cannot otherwise be administered outside school hours. All daily early morning and late afternoon medications will be administered by your child's school nurse during their work hours. Daily medications will only be administered by WonderCare staff during vacations and holidays when the school nurse does not work. Parents must provide separate medications and medical orders for WonderCare. There is no sharing of medication between the school Health Office and WonderCare.

HEALTH/EMERGENCY INFORMATION

In order to keep your child safe, WonderCare staff have access to any medical alerts documented by the school nurse on WCSD's Infinite Campus for teachers and staff. Even though staff may be communicating with your child's school nurse, you are responsible for assuring that WonderCare staff are aware of your child's health needs and have the necessary paperwork and forms. If your child has special health needs, medication in school and/or an Individual Health or Action Plan, you will be required to meet with Wondercare Directors and your child's on site coordinator two weeks before
