## **WCSD ANNOUNCES SCHOOL START-TIME COMMUNITY FORUM - TUESDAY, JUNE 5**

At the request of the board of education during its November 2, 2017, meeting, Webster CSD began to explore, study, and problem-solve around the complex issue of potential changes to school start times. Since the first district-wide start time study group meeting on January 31, elementary and secondary work groups comprised of district parents, teachers, administrators, and local medical professionals have been meeting throughout the spring to gather further community feedback and to discuss possible next steps. In addition, Webster CSD Superintendent Carmen Gumina has personally interviewed more than 900 middle and high school students to get their thoughts on any potential changes to school start times.

All of the information gathered by the elementary and secondary work groups will be shared during a Webster CSD School Start-Time Community Forum on Tuesday, June 5, at the Willink Middle School cafeteria, 900 Publishers Parkway, from 5:45 - 6:45 p.m. The One Webster community is invited to not only hear the groups' findings, but also to provide further feedback as this critical issue for our students is studied.

As previously shared, this is not a short-term study. If the board of education determines that changes in Webster CSD are necessary and possible, those changes wouldn't take place until fall 2019, however, it is important that the district continues to research this critical issue. Please plan to attend this important community forum on a topic that impacts all Webster CSD students.

### May Health Office News

Here are a few important End of School reminders:

#### **PICK UP SCHOOL MEDICATIONS DATE: June 19<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> 8-2.**

If your child has medications you **MUST** pick them up on these dates or they will be discarded. The Health office is not able to keep medications over the summer.

#### **NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR PHYSICALS:**

There is a change in New York State law which now requires a current physical examination for all students upon **entering the school district for the first time and upon entering grades K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11.** The examination must be completed and signed by a New York State licensed healthcare provider. A Dental Certificate which states your child has been evaluated by a dentist or dental hygienist is also requested at the same time.

- Physical and dental exams must be dated within 12 months of the student starting school..
- All physical exams must be submitted within 30 days of the student starting school.
- If your child has an appointment scheduled during this school year that is after the first 30 days of school, please notify the school health office of the date.
- Most physical exam forms from your healthcare provider's office are accepted; however, summaries from patient portal electronic medical records are not.
- District forms may be accessed via the school's health office webpage.

If your child has a physical, dental visit or specialist (eye, internal or other) over the summer, you can drop the documents at the State Road main office, or have the provider FAX them directly to the **Health Office Confidential FAX @ 585-872-7781.**

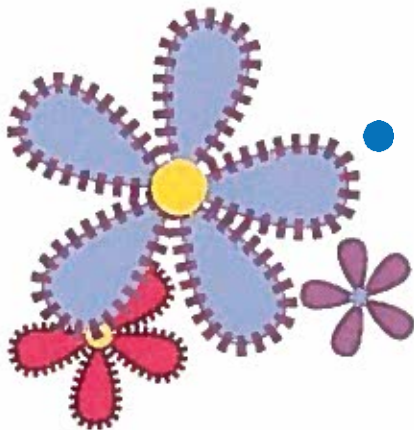

**Contact Information Updates:**

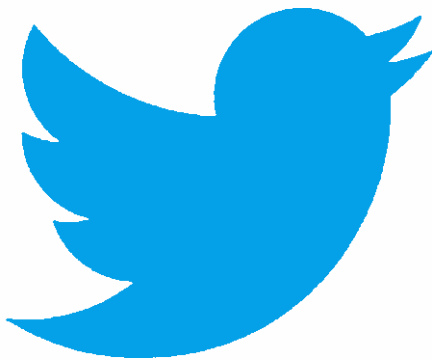
It is extremely important that we are able to contact you during the day, so please notify the office anytime there is a change to your phone, email or mailing address.

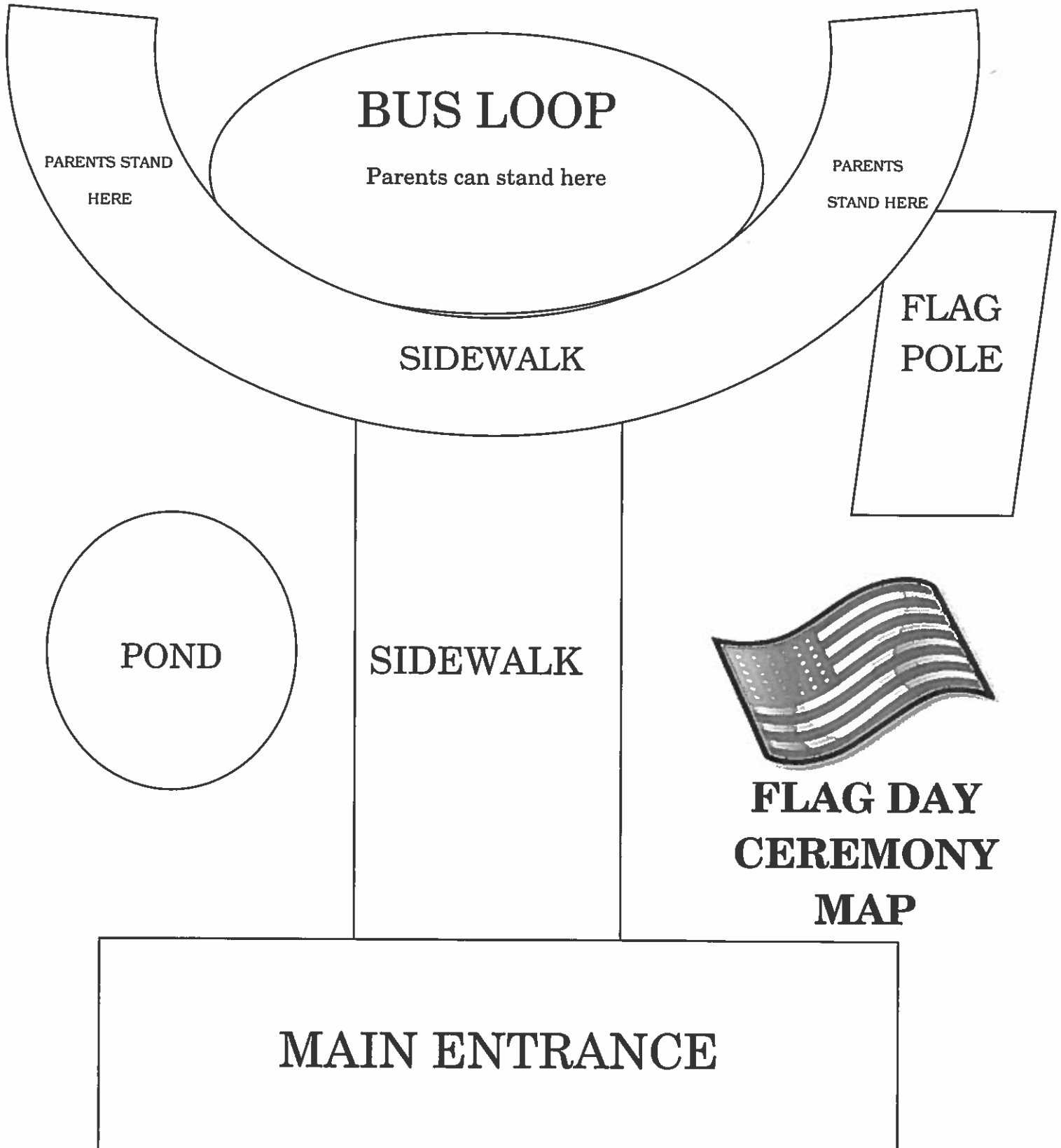

# Webster Youth Triathlon



**Race Information:** Sunday, June 3, 2018 at the Webster Aquatic Center - 875 Ridge Rd, Webster  
8:00-8:30 Check in and same day registration  
8:50 Transition area closes. All athletes and parents report to observation deck.  
9:00 Races begin - Age groups will go from oldest to youngest

Age	Swim	Bike	Run
12-16	150 yds	4 miles	1 mile
10-11	100 yds	3 miles	$\frac{3}{4}$ mile
8-9	75 yds	2 miles	$\frac{1}{2}$ mile
K-7	25yds	1 mile	$\frac{1}{4}$ mile

The swim will take place in the Webster Aquatic Center. Lifeguards will be on duty. Bubbles will be available to all swimmers who need them. ALL swimmers in the Kindergarten through 7 years old age group are required to wear a bubble- **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Immediately following the swim, athletes will make their way to the transition area where they will get their bike. There will be plenty of volunteers in the transition area and on the course. We ask that ALL parents stay out of the transition area and off the course. **HELMETS ARE REQUIRED!**

Upon completion of the bike portion of their race, athletes will go back through the transition area and leave their bike and head out on their run.  
Both the bike and run portion of the triathlon will take place on the Webster Schroeder campus.

There is also a team relay option. Register as an individual and note the friends you are teaming up with and what leg of the event each will be doing.



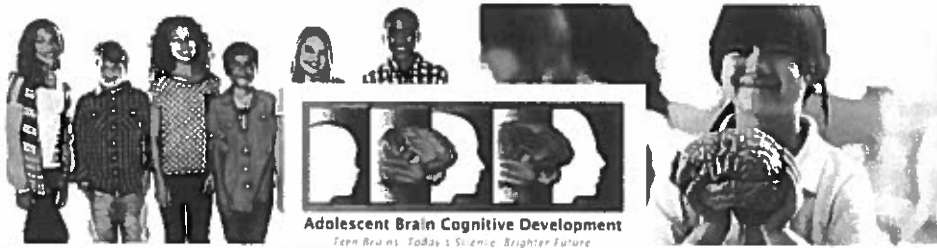
## What will you have to do?

The ABCD Study begins with 1-2 visits to a study site near you. During these visits, we will ask you to:

- Answer questions about your hobbies, sleep patterns, friendships, school, etc. But you do not have to tell us anything you do not want to.
- Play *games* and *puzzles* on an iPad, and
- Have your brain scanned in an MRI. MRI is like a camera that takes pictures of your brain. Sometimes you will get to watch movies in the MRI!

You might also win *prizes* and see pictures of your brain!

The results of the ABCD study will provide information about how the brain changes over time and how your experiences shape who you will become as an adult.
