It is hard to believe that we are already in May! This is a busy time of year for you as families and for the staff of State Road as well. This time of year for us is the "cross road" where we take care of what needs to be done to finish the year, while simultaneously planning for next year.

Budget Vote May 15th—The annual school budget vote and Board of Education election will be held on Tuesday, May 15. Polls will be open between 6 am and 9 pm in the Webster Schroeder High School gymnasium, 875 Ridge Road. The proposed budget will continue to support all school programs; academics, fine arts, athletics, special education, and extra-curricular programs. Every vote is important!

Dress Code: With the warmer weather, we would like to remind you of components of our school dress codes. Your child's footwear needs to be safe for the activity involved. As an example, playing basketball at recess with flip flops would not be appropriate. We also want to ensure that undergarments are covered including shoulder straps. Please review these components below (taken from our school handbook) when planning your child's school attire:

1. Include footwear at all times. Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed.
2. Ensure that undergarments and midriff are completely covered with outer clothing.
3. Recognize that as one matures physically, brief garments such as tube tops and spaghetti straps are not appropriate.

Bus Loop Parking:

Please do not park in the bus loop during school hours. This is especially important between the hours of 8:00-9:30AM and 2:00 – 3:30 PM. Thank you!

The Kiwanis Kids held a Penny Drive for the Mia Foundation, an organization which helps animals with disabilities and raised a total of \$375.00!

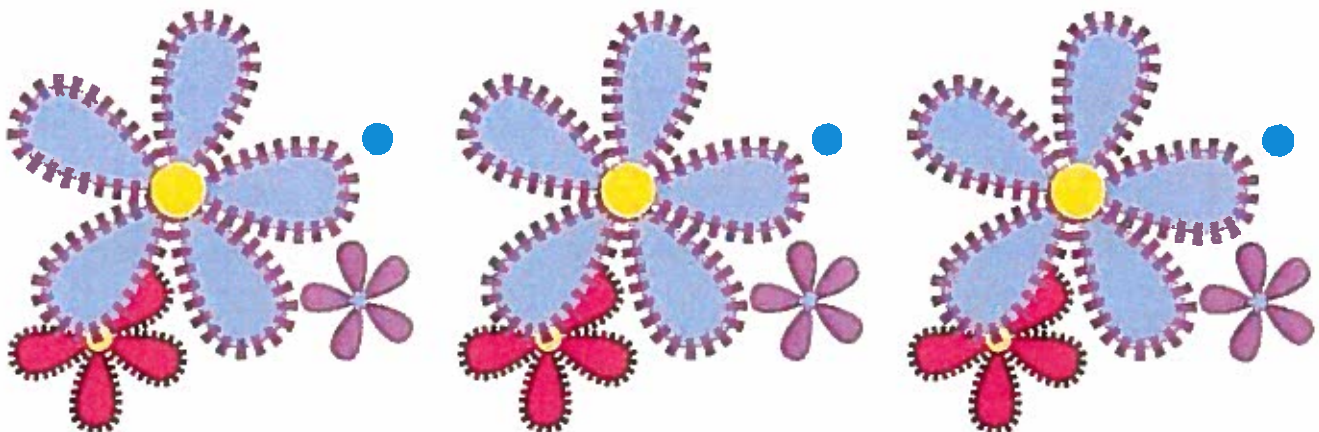

A-Z countdown to summer starts! We are excited for the Bubble Guy to visit on May 15.

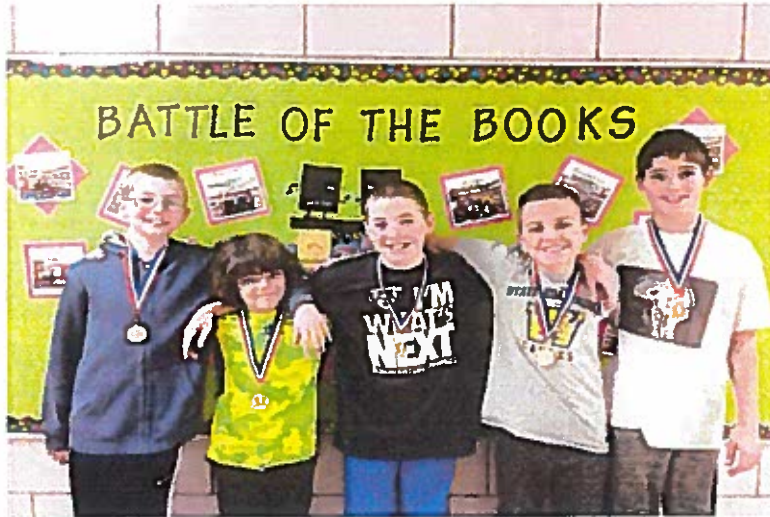
First Grade News:

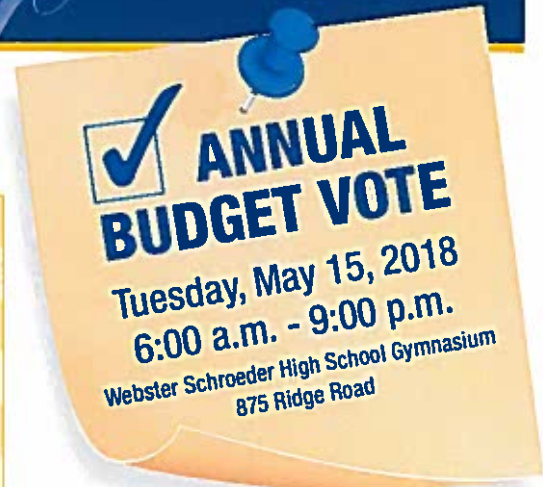


2018-19 Webster School District Budget Highlights

Proposed 2018-19 Budget	\$172,316,603
Budget-to-Budget Increase	2.59%
Property Tax Levy	\$103,850,795
% Change in Property Tax Levy/Tax Cap	3.0%
Estimated % Change in Tax Rate	1.34%*

The impact of the estimated 2018-19 tax rate increase on a WCSD home assessed at \$191,700 (per Zillow.com estimated averages) is \$63.15 or \$5.26 per month.


* Final tax rates will be set in August and are subject to change pending final assessments and equalization rates.



Fast Facts About the 2018-19 Budget

- All academic, fine arts, athletics, special education, and extra-curricular programs are supported by the 2018-19 budget.
- WCSD continues to have one of the lowest school true tax rates in Monroe County and per pupil spending in Monroe County (per pupil spending is also below NYS averages).
* Data from Monroe County School Boards Association, *Facts & Figures* - January 2018 and The NYS School Report Card for Fiscal Responsibility - 2016-17, most recent available
- Key factors impact the 2018-19 budget:
 - **Foundation Aid** - WCSD received a 1.93% increase or \$545,253. However, because the Foundation Aid formula wasn't fully funded for the 2018-19 fiscal year, WCSD will be shortchanged \$6,421,056 in state aid for 2018-19.
 - **Tax Levy Limit ("Cap") and Property Tax Rebate Plan** – For the seventh straight year, WCSD stayed at or below the calculated tax "cap." As a result, WCSD residents will be eligible for the tax rebate plan once again. It is estimated that the rebate will more than cover any projected tax bill increases.
- Actions that have been taken to control costs:
 - **Zero-based Budgeting Process**
 - **Cooperative Bidding and Purchasing**
 - **Use of District Reserve Funds** – estimated at just over \$2 million for 2018-19.
- WCSD is a member of many consortias to save money: Healthcare, Worker's Compensation, Accident & Liability Insurance.
- The 2018-19 budget supports a balance between two of the District's core beliefs: *Students First* and *Fiscal Responsibility*.

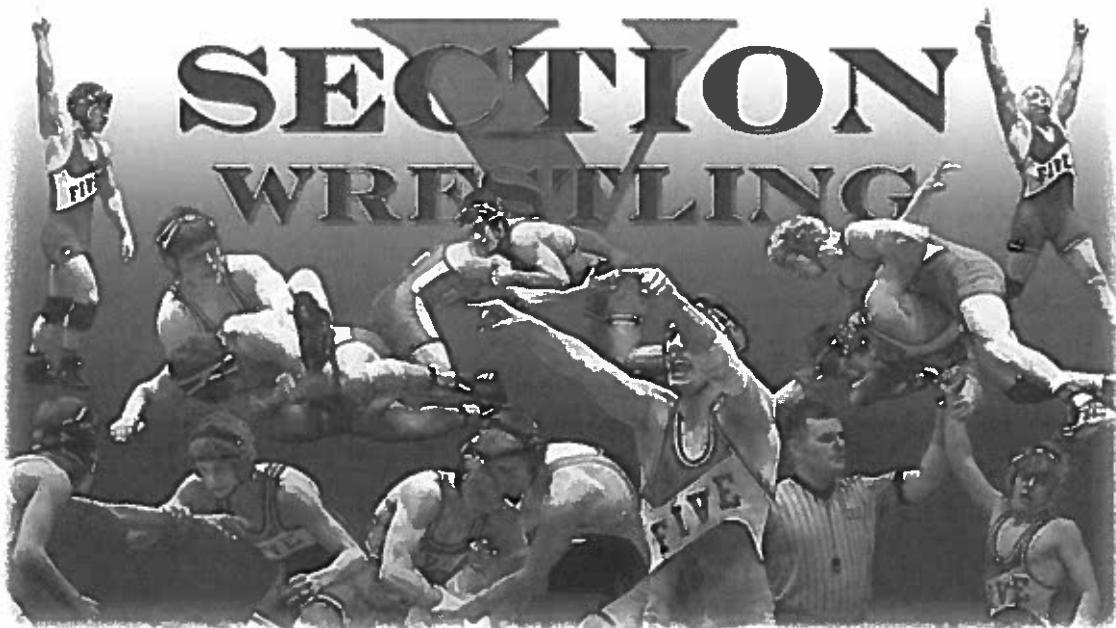

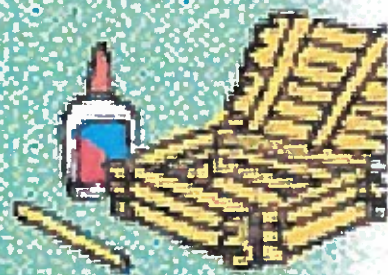
