






How we make it simple to see your doctors

You are covered the same in or out of network



Aetna Medicare Advantage Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) ESA

- Access to Medicare providers nationwide
- No referrals needed
- Over 1,100,000 network providers and over
 4,300 network hospitals*
- See any Medicare doctor at the same in-network cost, as long as they are:
 - Eligible to receive payment under Medicare
 - Willing to bill Aetna
- Covers you nationally when traveling
- Worldwide coverage for emergency and urgent care

Terms for understanding Medicare medical benefits

Network

A list of doctors, hospitals, and other providers who have a contract with an insurer to participate in the network.

In-Network

Providers who have a contract with an insurer to participate in the network.

Out-of-Network

Providers who do not have a financial contract with an insurer.

HMO

Health Maintenance Organization

A limited network of local doctors.

Generally, only emergency care is covered out of network.

Requires referrals for specialty care and a PCP.

PPO

Preferred Provider Organization

Has in-network and out-of-network providers.

If you use out-ofnetwork providers you pay more.

Generally, a larger list of in-network providers than HMO.

Aetna Passive PPO with Extended Service Area (ESA)

Has in-network and out of network providers.

Nation-wide network includes 85% of Medicare providers nationally.

Retirees pay the same cost for all Medicare providers in or out-of-network.

Prescription drug benefits



Terms for understanding prescription drug benefits

Formulary

A list of drugs covered in your plan.

Drug tiers

A group of drugs in a formulary.

Network

Pharmacies you can use to fill prescription drugs.

Transition process

Possible one-time fill of a noncovered drug.





Prescription drug coverage rules

Prior authorization (PA)

Some drugs require that your doctor first show a medical need for you to use the drug before the plan will cover it.

Quantity limits (QLs)

This places a limit on how much of a drug you can get at one time.

Step therapy (ST)

You must first try another drug on the plan's formulary before you can move to another drug.

Note: The above rules are in place today for safety purposes and to help keep your costs down.

The prescriptions you fill regularly are conveniently delivered to your door within 10 days after processing your order.

Two easy steps to get started:

- 1. See if your medication is available through mail order.
 - Check your plan formulary (drug list) or call the number on your member ID card.
- 2. Choose how to sign up:
 - Register online through your member website.
 - Call Member Services at the number on your member ID card.

	Part D Drug Plan
Deductible	None
Tier 1 – Generics	Cost shown on benefit summary
Tier 2 - Preferred Brand	Cost shown on benefit summary
Tier 3 - Non-Preferred Brand	Cost shown on benefit summary
Coverage gap / Donut Hole	Same costs as above
Catastrophic phase	\$0 copay if true out of pocket (TrOOP) cost reaches \$8,000
Mail-order drugs	CVS Caremark






