

2025 AIA Rochester High School Scholarship Application

SCHOLARSHIP OFFERINGS & CRITERIA:

All applications must be complete and emailed by April 4, 2025 to be considered. All scholarship monies must be used towards school expenses. A combined total of \$30,000 may be awarded.

Confirm you qualify for a scholarship by checking the box adjacent. You may select multiple scholarships:

AIA Rochester and Rochester Architecture Foundation (RAF) Sponsored Scholarships

- Applicant must be a resident of any of the seven (7) counties, or member-firm areas served by AIA Rochester.
- Applicants must be accepted and enrolled in an architecture college program for the Fall 2025 academic term. Preference will be given to students in a NAAB accredited degree program.
- Emphasis for consideration is based upon the student's written response, which should address the primary reasons driving the decision to enter the profession, and indicate what sparks a sense of passion and dedication to improving the built environment. Additional emphasis will be placed upon the applicant's contributions to the community via civic, academic, social, and leadership activities, as well as the strength of the letter(s) of reference.

Myron Starks Memorial Scholarship

- Applicant must be a resident of any of the seven (7) counties, or member-firm areas served by AIA Rochester.
- Applicants must be accepted and enrolled in an architecture college program for the Fall 2025 academic term.

Rochester Architecture Foundation's Urban Scholar Award

- Applicant must be a resident of the City of Rochester and be a graduating senior of a high school located within the City of Rochester.
- Applicants must be accepted and enrolled in one of the following for the fall of 2025:
 - An architecture college program
 - A college program in a field related to architecture, including civil engineering, structural engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, plumbing & fire protection engineering, urban planning, landscape architecture, construction management, and interior design.
 - OR a technical construction trade program
- Applicants must provide total cost of the program they are attending in the fall of 2025 and identify other grants/awards already received.
