- ❑ **Registration Dates:** Registration for Watercize classes stays open for the first half of the session. Rates cannot be prorated for those who register for a partial session of Watercize. Students are encouraged to make up missed classes. Makeups must be completed within the same session. **You must be a member at the time of registration in order to receive the half off discounted price.**
- ❑ **Attendance:** PATRONS are required to **sign-in** at the front desk *before* entering the pool area.

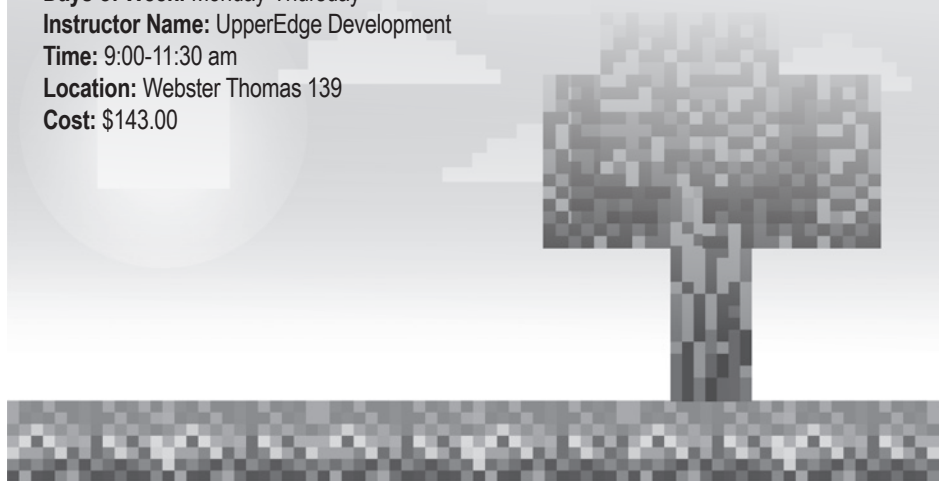

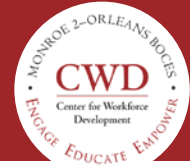
